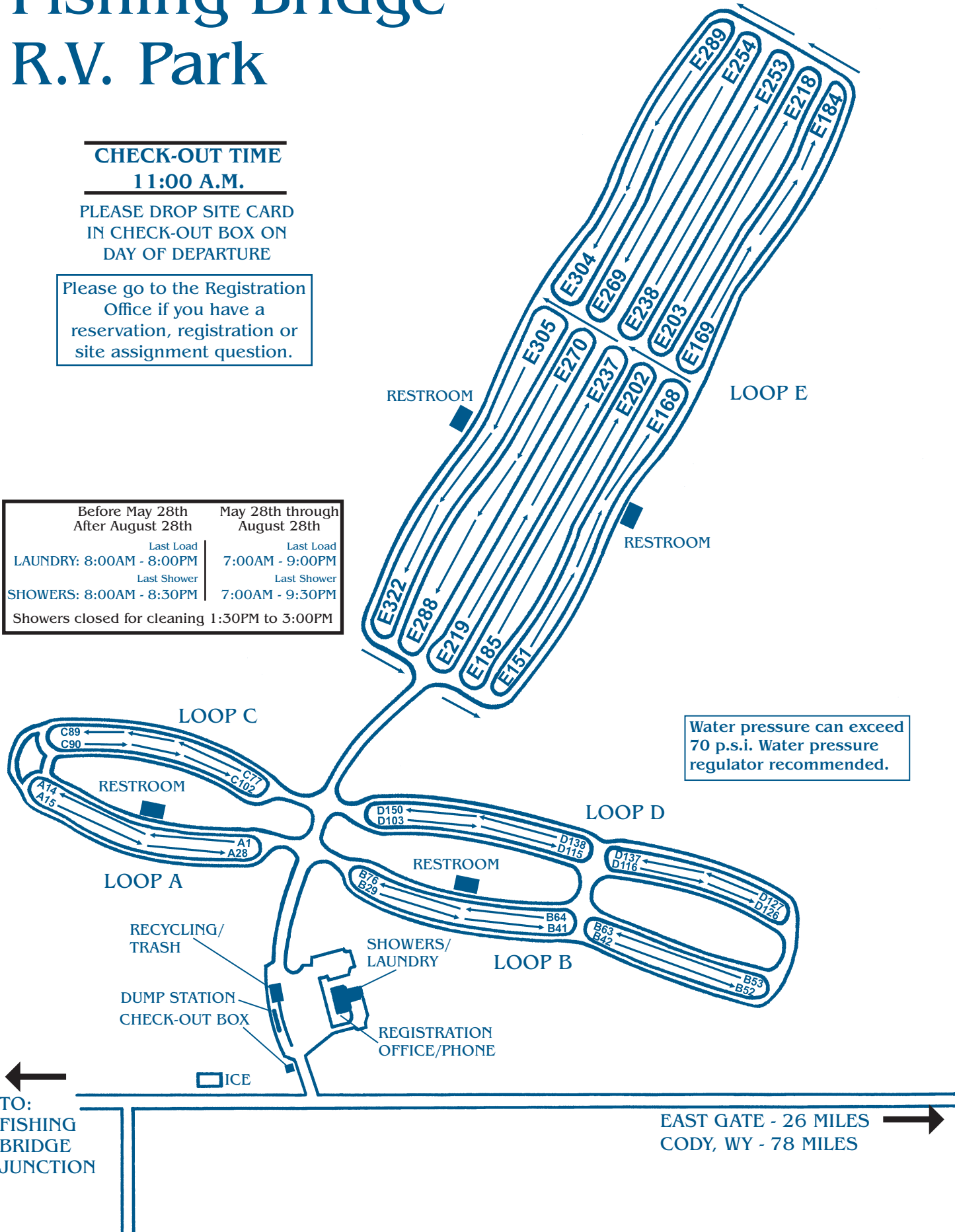

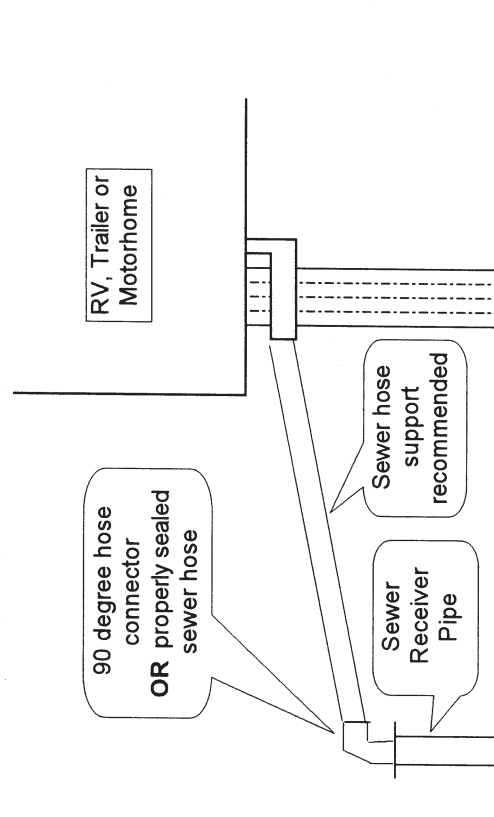
Welcome to Fishing Bridge RV Park

WATER - We have fluctuating water pressure; we strongly recommend the use of a water regulator.

IN FREEZING TEMPERATURES - Please leave unused hook-up valves open to permit a tiny stream of water to flow and do the same with one faucet inside your R.V.

SEWER - A sealed connection between your hose and the sewer receiver pipe is required. You may use an elbow or donut type seal. Please let us know if your hose slips into the pipe and you are unable to retrieve it.

Water pressure regulators and sewer connectors are available for sale at the Registration Office. Please help us conserve water.



If you have questions, our staff will be happy to assist you.

IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, PLEASE DIAL 911

If you require ranger assistance, please stop by the office during regularly scheduled hours. If we are closed, please dial 911 from the pay phones located outside the laundry area.

Campground Guidelines for a safe and enjoyable stay in Yellowstone National Park

Hard-Sided Units ONLY.

NO TENTS and NO UNITS with CANVAS allowed.

ALL wheeled units, including trailers MUST stay on the pavement at all times.

NO CAMPFIRES ALLOWED.

- * Please use caution, always drive slowly while in the campground.
- * Charcoal & Gas Grills are permitted but must be stored inside your unit when not in use.
- * No bicycles allowed on trails or off the pavement. Use of rollerblades/skateboards/scooters is prohibited.
- * Quiet Hours are 10 PM - 6 AM. Generator may not exceed 60 decibels at 50 feet and their use is allowed from 8 AM - 8 PM.
- * No washing vehicles at your campsite.
- * Please do not idle engines.
- * Keep a clean campsite. ALL trash, garbage and litter **MUST** be disposed of in the provided dumpsters.
- * Please recycle! See other side for location.
- * Pets **MUST** be on a leash and in owner's control at all times. Pets may not be more than 100 feet from roads and parking areas. Pets are **NOT ALLOWED** on trails. Please pick up after your pet.
- * Camping is permitted in designated sites **ONLY**.

CHECK-OUT TIME IS 11:00 AM.

Please drop your site card in the check-out box upon final departure. If you are planning to leave before your scheduled departure date, you **MUST** come in to the Registration Office with your site card and show-er card in order to be eligible for a refund. Changes to your reservation will result in a \$25 charge. Cancellation or early departure may result in forfeiture of the amount of one night's stay.



WARNING: FOOD and ODORS attract BEARS!

For your safety, the following items (new, clean, dirty, empty, or full) may NOT be left outside at any time, day or night, unless they are in immediate use. ANY ITEM WITH AN ODOR

- * Food or Food Containers
- * Water and Beverage Containers
- * Pet Food or Pet Water Containers
- * Eating and Drinking Utensils
- * Cook Stoves or Grills
- * Ice Chests or Coolers
- * Trash, Garbage or Litter

To ensure your safety, any violation of these regulations may result in a citation and/or confiscation of these items by the National Park Service.

Failure to comply may result in property damage, injury or death of a person and/or the removal or death of a bear from the Yellowstone ecosystem.

When hiking, carry bear spray and hike in groups of three or more.
